The course consists of a two day in class orientation January 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020, online training, in class review days (every 4-5 weeks) and a one week in class review and exam in June 2020. All in class sessions take place at NSCC Akerley Campus, Dartmouth.

Nova Scotia participants cost for the course will be around \$250.00 plus tax.
