## **RFA Nova Scotia Second Class Refrigeration Course**

The Recreation Facility Association of Nova Scotia Second Class Refrigeration committee is preparing to offer the next On-line Second Class Refrigeration Arena course. If your facility needs a ticketed operator for your refrigeration plant to meet current labour standards, this is the course for you.

The course consists of a two day in class orientation on January 2 & 3, 2019 at the Akerley NSCC Campus in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia, on-line training (approximately four months – 8 hours a week). This includes 3 separate in class review days, followed by a one week in class review and exam June 24 – 28, 2019.

Nova Scotia participants cost for the course will be around \$250.00 plus tax.

2. Minimum of grade 12 or GED
