COURSE OVERVIEW

The combination of the Arena Level 1 and the Ice Maintenance course will have participants participate in both classroom instruction and practical sessions and do a full two-day install, including making ice, marking lines, painting, logos, and maintenance of artificial ice surfaces.

TOPICS INCLUDE

1. Basic refrigeration theory
2. Changing the blade and levelling
3. Preventative maintenance on the ice resurfer
4. Safety concerns
5. Proper shaving and flooding techniques
6. Proper use of an edger and hand edging
7. Line and board repairs
8. Changing glass
9. Janitorial concerns
